Abuh forest is one of the 11 community forests in Boyo Division. It is the only forest developed for eco-tourism by the Community Forest FO in conjunction with BERUDA, and visitors can now enter the forest with a guide.

This trek will open your eyes to the diversity and splendor of the North West highland forests. Along the way, you will experience the natural beauty of the hillside farms, ancient forest, plateau grasslands, swamp and a hidden sacred cave with a waterfall flowing over the entrance.

Abuh forest is also home to the famously endemic Bannerman's Turaco, a magnificent red crested bird found nowhere else in the world.

Itinerary

- 7:00 Meet at BERUDA visitor's centre in Belo
- 7:30 Taxi to Fundong (BERUDA staff member to greet)
- 8:45 Motorcycle to Abuh village
- 9:30 Meet guide in Abuh village and begin trek
- 12:00 Break for lunch
- 14:00 Return to Abuh village
- 14:30 Begin trek to BERUDA's Fundong office (BERUDA staff member to greet)
- 16:30 Taxi back to Belo (17:30 arrival)
