This is an easy trek from Belo around the rural district of Anyajua.

Enjoy the scenes of everyday life in the countryside as you follow the path of the stream. The guide will take you to a hidden waterfall, followed by a visit the second-class chief in his traditional house. The second-class chief is next in rank from the Fon.

Afterwards, stop in on a traditional dressmakers' workshop and meet the head of the tribal security council.

This tour is a great mixture of trekking and culture.
