Trek from Fundong to a hilltop palace in the clouds and enjoy an audience with the Fon - chief of the Kom tribe. Meet his many wives and children and learn about the culture from the tribal elders.

You must bring a gift (bottle of honey) and an offering (entry fee) to be granted an audience, but once inside you can remain in the king's court and watch the traditional cases and tribal matters.

The Fon will expect you to eat lunch (traditional food made by his wives) and have a drink with him.



Itinerary

- 7:00 Meet at BERUDA visitor's centre in Belo
- 7:30 Take taxi to Fundong
- 8:30 Begin trek to Liakom Palace (11:00 arrival)

(note: you also have the option of taking a motorcycle)

- 16:00 Return trek to Fundong

(note: you can leave as early as you like, but no later than 16:00)

- 18:00 Taxi to Belo

Please Note

This is a traditional 'palace' - do not expect western standards. It is, however, one of the most preserved palaces in the country and has not seen the effects of modernization.

You can stay in court as long as you please.

Some areas of the palace are off limits, however as a tourist it is possible to pay a little extra to see some of the secret chambers.
