



Ndong Aweh Hill Trek

A lovely trek to the highest peak in Belo: Ndong Aweh hill.

The double-humped peak dominates the skyline to the North and is a nice two-hour trek to the summit. On the summit is a beautiful monument representing Calvary Hill and the crucifixion. On a clear day the views from the peak give a stunning 360-degree view of the region.

Bring a packed lunch and enjoy the fresh air and landscape from the top. On your descent, stop at a craft workshop and watch the carver make his wares.
